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### **RELATIONS WITH EFSA**

We must admit that because of its existence, food safety in Europe is one of the highest in the world.

Most failures are not the failure of EFSA but the control and state authorities in the Member States.

A typical example is the egg scandal and fipronil and its tutoring by the Dutch and Belgian state institutions so as not to endanger the business of their farmers and processors.

Procedures may sometimes be too complicated, perhaps too much of a struggle for "absolute" independence from industry and the purity of processes at the expense of their speed and quality.

However, the EFSA as an institution has respect from industry. The industry wants to cooperate and communicate with EFSA to the benefit of the consumer.

### **RELATIONS WITH EFSA**

## Where do we see the main problem of the present and the future?

EFSA is part of the European legislative process, its structure, decision-making and consultation processes, and the way in which risk assessments are taken, are fairly accepted.

## It would therefore be desirable that its opinions be the only binding decision for the EC and the Member States.

There are too many parallel and shadow organizations with unclear goals, unclear structure, and decision-making processes that engulf with their opinions, often different or even contradictory to EFSA's views and recommendations, the legislative and decision-making processes in Europe.

The first is the **WHO** and its organization, and **IARC** is at the top of the list.

### **RELATIONS WITH EFSA**

I do not have to mention an affair about the evaluation of aspartame, the carcinogenicity of meat and meat products, the manipulation of data about the influence of alcohol on health or the current activity around glyphosate.

In the second place, it is the **OECD**, which is becoming an increasingly active activist and its goals and processes are very vague and the methodologies questionable.

That is why we see the growing potential of EFSA if it is willing and able to grasp these challenges.

Legislative process can not be created and managed by activists, but lobbyists can take part in it.
